

Dear Friends,

We are privileged to continue the BMS (Prairie) chess program, which is run by the 2008 U.S. Champion, Grandmaster Yury Shulman. The program will run after school at Barrington Middle School (Prairie campus – exact location will be announced later) on Thursdays from 2:50 till 3:50 PM. Students will be supervised until 4:25 (activity bus pick up). It is open to K-5 students. Students will be engaged in learning chess, leadership programs, researching and presenting on history and geography related to chess, organizing tournaments, and serving the local community. Chess students will be featured periodically in local and national newspapers, if they wish.

Structure

Half the students will receive instruction for 30 minutes while the other half will participate in supervised play. The two groups will switch for the next 30 minutes.

Most of the material covered in lessons as well as homework will be taken from the 2nd edition of the book "Chess! Lessons from a Grandmaster" It is available in class. The price for our students is \$23, including tax and 15% discount. After reading and submitting all of the Homework from the book and volunteering requirements, students may achieve Chess Coach Certification. 
