

# **US Chess Champion GM Yury Shulman program** Pleasant Hill Elementary School Chess Club - Fall 2023



#### Dear Friends,

We are privileged to continue Pleasant Hill Elementary school chess program, which is run by Chess Without Borders organization and the 2008 U.S. Champion, Grandmaster Yury Shulman. The program is Open to K-6 Pleasant Hill Elementary students and will run after school in the Pleasant Hill Elementary on Wednesdays from 3:10 till 4:10 PM. Students will be engaged in learning chess, leadership programs, researching and presenting on history and geography related to chess, organizing tournaments, and serving the local community. Chess students will be featured periodically in local and national newspapers if they wish.

#### **Structure**

The students would be divided in two groups based on their levels. Half the students will receive instruction for 30 minutes while the other half will participate in supervised play. The two groups will switch for the next 30 minutes. Most of the material covered in lessons as well as homework will be taken from our textbook - the 3rd edition of the book "Chess! Lessons from a Grandmaster" It is available in class and very much recommended for new students. The price for our participants is \$20, including tax and 25% discount.
